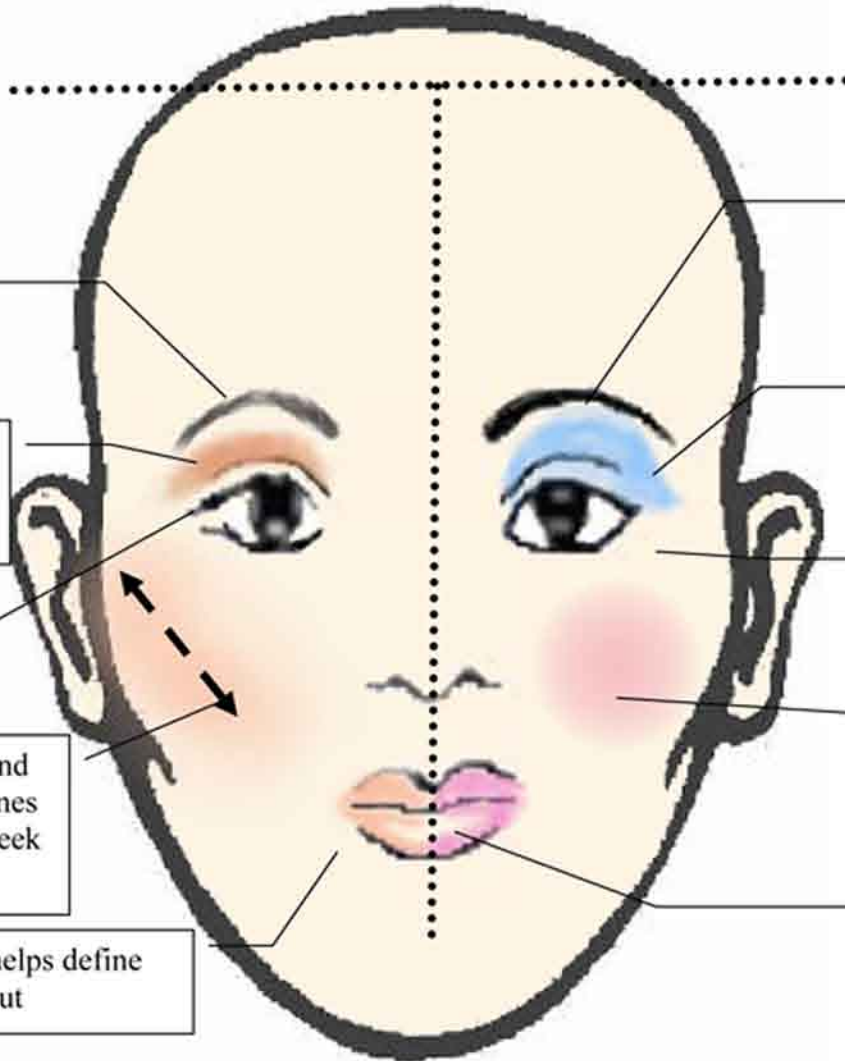


# Basic Make-up

## Right

## Wrong



Eyebrows are enhanced but look natural

Eyeshadow (if any) is a natural color and well blended

Eyeliner is open at both ends

Blush is a natural shade and is blended along cheekbones (from the center of the cheek toward the temple)

Lipcolor is natural and helps define lips but does not stand out

Eyebrows are too dark and unnatural

Eyeshadow too dramatic, color not natural

Eyeliner is closed at both ends of the eye

Blush too bright and not blended along cheekbone

Lipcolor is too bright-not a natural looking shade.

### STEPS:

- **Foundation** - Even out entire face with foundation. If foundation looks patchy, remove foundation, apply moisturizer, wait a few minutes, then start again. Blend foundation around edges of face and under jawline so there isn't a dark line between face and neck. If you can leave a mark in the foundation by drawing your finger across it, you have applied it too heavily.
- **Blush** - Add blush to enhance cheekbones. Place blush along the line of cheekbones (from the 'apple of the cheek' to the temple—not in a circle in the middle of the cheek. Blend edges well.
- **Eyeliner** - Apply dark brown or black eyeliner, leaving the outer corners open (as shown above). **LEAVE EYELINER OPEN at edges!!!** (see picture) **VERY IMPORTANT:** Lightly dust entire face with setting powder if using a crème-based foundation
- **Mascara** - Apply mascara to upper and lower lashes. After mascara is dry...

**DO NOT Apply lipstick, eyeshadow OR anything to eyebrows. The hair and makeup committee will do this after your child arrives at the show.**

**This makeup should be applied at home BEFORE Makeup Call. Be sure your child arrives to Makeup Call with makeup done and makeup kit in hand!**
