All boys should have their hair neatly combed away from their face and behind ears, use gel as needed.

Please put hair in bun, for a NY City lawyer look.

Follow Wannabe instructions below.

Two braided pigtails-possibly with wire--or crimped hair--please come with clean hair and H&M will style

Neat straight or slightly curled under hair. Bangs should be away from face. H&M will add accessories.

Neat "Louis Lane" reporter look--Please come with clean, dry hair and H&M will style.

Follow Wannabe instructions below.

Please put hair in low ponytail with bangs away from face.

Neat straight or slightly curled under hair. Bangs should be away from face. H&M will add accessories.

Old ladyish bun, please come with bangs away from face in low ponytail.

Twisted up in the back secured with clip, pencil in twist. Please come with clean hair--H&M will style.

Follow Wannabe instructions below.

Young and hip; hair will be half-up in twisty bun. Please come with clean, dry hair and H&M will style.

Straight & chic look. Please come with Straight hair if possible. Use flat iron if needed. H&M will add accessories.

Follow Wannabe instructions below.

The Wannabes should have curly hair--think beauty pageant. We ask that you have your daughters sleep in sponge rollers and leave them in until the performance. The Hair and Make-up team will style the girls hair and bag the curlers so they can be used for each performance. If you do not have sponge rollers, they can be purchased at most drug stores, such as CVS/Walgreens, or at stores such as Target/Walmart.

Instructions for setting hair with sponge rollers:

- 1) Wash hair in the evening and start with slightly damp hair
- 2) Comb out a small section of hair
- 3) Spray lightly with setting spray, any brand is fine
- 4) Roll the section of hair around roller and clip
- 5) Leave hair in rollers until performance--yes, they will have to wear their rollers to school on some days.
