

# **BASIC MAKEUP APPLICATION**

for Preview Night, Performances and Rehearsals when Required

**Parent to Apply at Home:** See Tips Below for specific instructions

- Concealer (under eyes and to cover blemishes as needed)
- Compact powder foundation (blended all the way down to the neck)
- Blush (apply to the apples of their cheeks, **not** their cheek bones—but do not make circles just lightly highlight the cheeks).
- Mascara (be generous), this goes for **boys as well**.
- Do Not Darken Eyebrows

**We apply for everyone after they arrive:**

- Lip liner and Lipstick
- Blush touchups
- Eyeliner and eye shadow as needed

**Parent Makeup Guidelines: Tips for Boys and Girls**

- 1) Start with a clean face (wash with soap before each application)
- 2) Apply concealer in needed areas - cover any blemishes or dark circles
- 3) Be sure to apply full coverage with the compact powder foundation (referred to as Crème Foundation in the Ben Nye Kit). Blend all the way down to the neck. Please go one shade darker than your child's skin tone with the powder. The powder should not be too light. When they get on stage, they will look washed out.
- 4) Apply blush on the apples of the cheeks. Have them smile with their mouth closed. Apply it to the cute, squishy, front - not up the cheek bones.
- 5) Mascara should be applied to the upper and lower eyelashes for **BOYS** and **GIRLS**. Be generous with the mascara. The lights will wash out your child quite a bit.
- 6) All items should be color appropriate for your child's skin tone. This will be very obvious problem from the audience if it is not considered. Please go slightly darker and blend. We are going for a natural look, not made up.
- 7) **Please do not apply eye liner, eye shadow, lipstick at home. We will apply as needed before the show.**
- 8) Please LABEL each item in your makeup bag individually with a sharpie For more tips on how to apply the base makeup see document titled "**Gone With the Breeze Natural Make Up**".

## **HAIR GUIDELINES**

**for Preview Night, Performances and Rehearsals when Required**

- Everyone **MUST** bring their own **LABELED** brush, bobby pins, hair spray and hair elastics (close to hair color) in a **LABELED BAG**. There will be NO sharing hair items, brushes or accessories
- All kids should have clean, freshly washed and dried hair before each performance.
- Boys: neat hair, use hair gel and hair spray to keep it in place. We don't want their hair getting in their eyes, especially for the cast members whom have dance scenes.

**Girls, please await further instruction for hair and costumes.**
